Three 5.2.0:
A new dual-strap system updates the Sun Mountain mainstay.

IT'S ALREADY the best-selling carry bag in company history. With the addition of a new dual-strap system to the Three 5 Bag, however, officials at Sun Mountain hope to make their popular product that much more appealing. The new strap system is a hybrid of the company's X-Strap and the E-Z Fit Strap. Both right and left straps are anchored on a circle that sits in the middle of a golfer's back, the right strap remaining fixed as the left slides on the center anchor to make the bag easier to pick up. The latest Three 5 (\$190), which weighs less than four pounds, carries over the line's other primary features, including a full-length pocket for clothing, a lined valuables pouch and a spot to carry a drink bottle. The lift handle at the top of the bag works with the new lower lift handle to make it easier to pull the bag out of your trunk. The men's model has 10 color options and the women's has four, with left-handed models also available. —Keely Levis
